I am pleased to share with you a report on news and events in this March 2025 edition of News from the Hill. We have three stories to share with you, beginning with Lillian Steinmayer's Senior Sermon that blended science and faith to teach us about how "God's demands of humility, equity, justice, and care are also requirements of the scientific method."

As we honor the conclusion of one student's journey, Andover Newton Seminary at Yale Divinity School celebrated the beginning of a new class on March 24th by welcoming newly admitted students to campus. In response to a record number of applicants this year, Founding Dean Sarah Drummond shared that "Andover Newton's presence at YDS is both a special selling point, and a difficult one to describe in sound bites. Therefore, these visits are essential so students can come to understand what is special about being part of a seminary for ministry formation within a divinity school that provides theological foundations. We have the best of both worlds to offer them."

One of those selling points was the feature of our faculty and program spotlight on Rev. Joanne Jennings and Andover Newton's Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) preparation course. The innovative course has been opening new doors for pastoral care education at Yale Divinity School just as CPE itself did when first introduced in the 1930s. Our history is important to us, which is a great reminder that you can still join us on April 10th to celebrate the Newton Theological Institution Bicentennial.

Planned festivities include the annual Bauer-Broholm Lecture featuring <u>Gina Jacobs-Strain</u>, General Secretary of American Baptist Churches USA; the opening of the Newton Bicentennial Archive Exhibit; and a celebratory dinner and hymnsing.
